


#### Readings for February 26, 2023

#### MISSION STATEMENT

We, the family of Most Holy Redeemer Parish, commit ourselves to enriching our relationship with God by following the teachings of Jesus Christ. With the guidance of the Holy Spirit, we continue to build the Kingdom of God in our midst. Our vision is to foster the faith of all through prayer, service, education, and ministry.

#### A MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR

The Archdiocese of Chicago, along with 15 other dioceses, is part of a pilot program being conducted by the Catholic Leadership Institute. The pilot program consists of two parts: the Priest Leadership Inventory and the Disciple Maker Index. Both of these are assessments designed to benefit individual priests and parishes. The program is being underwritten by a grant.

In the Priest Leadership Inventory, each priest does a self- assessment of himself and his priestly ministry, including his preferences and passions, strengths, and style of ministry. Each priest can also have up to 3 other priests or colleagues offer their perspective on the priest and his ministry. The results will be used to help each individual priest form a plan for his own growth and receive the coaching and mentoring he will need. The results will also help in the placement of priests in their assignments. Archdiocese-wide, the results will help in the design of ongoing leadership formation for priests.

The Disciple Maker Index invites parishioners to reflect on where they are in their own personal journey to discipleship, and to identify their parish's effectiveness in supporting that journey. The survey consists of 75 questions. It is estimated that it will take 15-20 minutes to do, not more than half an hour at most. The results of the Disciple Maker Index will help parish leadership to make data-driven decisions on priorities that will help parishioners grow in faith.

The results of the Priest Leadership Inventory will be shared with the individual priest, his pastor or direct supervisor, the local Vicar, the Vicar for Priests, the Priest Placement Board, and the Cardinal. The Disciple Maker Index results will be shared with parish leadership. A summary of the results and planned actions will be shared with all parishioners. Local Vicars, the Vicariate staff, select Archdiocesan staff (such as the Office for Evangelization), the Priest Placement Board, and the Cardinal will also have access to the results.

Each pastor chooses someone, usually from the parish staff, to serve as the Primary Point of Contact (PPOC) for the Disciple Maker Index. The PPOC's job is to work with the pastor to publicize the survey and encourage participation, share the data with parish leadership, and work with the pastor to communicate the results and next steps to the parish. I have asked Dan Turney, our school principal, to serve in this role.

The survey will be conducted online. We can get paper copies of the survey if you are unable to access the internet. Please watch the bulletin and our social media for information over the coming weeks about how to access the survey. The opportunity to take part in the survey will end on March 31. The survey is confidential and anonymous. The goal is to have as many people as possible take part in the survey. The results will help us as we move forward in the Renew My Church initiative. I hope you will take part in this survey in the coming weeks.






