A MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR

It is the time of the year for the Annual Catholic Appeal. Every year, we are asked to make a generous pledge to the Annual Catholic Appeal. By supporting the Annual Catholic Appeal, we recognize that the Church is more than just our parish or even our Archdiocese. Through the Annual Appeal, we support the work of the larger Church.

The Annual Catholic Appeal helps to support parishes and schools serving financially challenged communities. The Appeal helps provide tuition assistance for disadvantaged Catholic school families. The Annual Appeal helps to fund the SPRED program that provides religious education for those with developmental disabilities. The Appeal helps fund the Kolbe House jail ministry. The Annual Appeal gives support to young adult and campus ministry, such as the St. John Paul II Newman Center at UIC. The Appeal supports outreach initiatives for young adults, families, and children. It supports ongoing formation for priests and spiritual renewal efforts in parishes. The Annual Appeal gives support to Catholic Relief Services, helping those suffering from natural disasters around the world.

The theme for the 2023 Annual Catholic Appeal is "Walking on the Road with Jesus." Jesus walks along with us on the road of life. He is always there. We are asked to walk together with Him, coming to know Him better, and seeing His presence in every person. Through the Annual Appeal, we walk with the Lord and help support His mission in our local Church and beyond. Every parish is given a goal to try to reach in the Annual Catholic Appeal. The goal is 7% of the previous year's offertory income. Our goal for this year is \$46,034.00. Any funds received above that figure will be given back to our parish as a rebate. Our generous support of the Annual Catholic Appeal not only helps the Archdiocese and the larger Church. It could also benefit our parish.

I will be speaking about the Annual Catholic Appeal at all the Masses this weekend. Next weekend, we will hear a recorded message from Cardinal Cupich. After that we will have the opportunity to make our commitment to the Annual Appeal. I will guide everyone through filling out the commitment form as we have done in previous years. There will be a follow-up the weekend of February 18-19 for those who missed the previous week.

If you have supported the Annual Catholic Appeal in previous years, you should have received the materials for this year's Appeal in the mail. If you did not receive the materials in the mail or have not previously supported the Annual Appeal, there are some pamphlets about the Appeal at the usher's tables in church. Please take some time to look the materials over. Keep in mind that this is not another second collection. We are being asked to make a generous commitment that we will fulfill over a number of months, allowing us to be more generous. You can return your commitment form in the mail. You can bring your completed commitment form with you to Mass and turn it in there. If you do not bring your completed commitment form to Mass, you will be asked to fill out a form at Mass. You can donate by phone by calling (312) 534-7959. You can make your gift to the Annual Appeal through stocks or IRA distributions if you wish.






