


#### Readings for March 12, 2023

#### A MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR

Monday, March 13, is the tenth anniversary of the election of Pope Francis. Throughout his papacy, Pope Francis has asked the People of God to pray for him. As we observe the tenth anniversary of his election, we are asked to say ten Hail Mary's on Monday for Pope Francis. You can learn more about this effort and register your name at <a href="https://www.archchicago.org">www.archchicago.org</a>. You can also light a candle for the Pope. We are asked to pray more during Lent. Let us use this Monday as an opportunity to pray more by offering ten Hail Mary's for Pope Francis.

Two weeks ago, I wrote about the Disciple Maker Index (DMI). The DMI is a survey that invites parishioners to reflect on where they are in their own personal journey to discipleship, and to identify their parish's effectiveness in supporting that journey. The survey consists of 75 questions. It is estimated that it will take 15-20 minutes to complete, no more than half an hour. The results of the Disciple Maker Index will help parish leadership to make data-driven decisions on priorities that will help parishioners grow in faith.

The survey is done on-line. Information about how to log on to the survey can be found elsewhere in the bulletin this week. If you wish to take part but do not have access to the internet, paper copies of the survey are available at the rectory. The survey is done anonymously. You can fill out the survey until the end of March. The goal is to have at least 500 parishioners take the survey. The more people who take it, the more accurate picture we will have of our parish. I hope you will take part in the Disciple Maker Index.

In previous years, when St. Patrick's Day fell on a Friday as it does this year, the Cardinal Archbishop\_has granted a dispensation from the obligation to abstain from eating meat on the Fridays of Lent. This past week, Bishop Casey, the Vicar General of the Archdiocese, sent out the following:

"The Archdiocese of Chicago is not granting a general dispensation for the Memorial of St. Patrick from the obligation to abstain from meat on Fridays in Lent. Instead, Catholics who find themselves at an event where meat is served in celebrating St. Patrick may in good conscience substitute the general rule of abstinence with another form of penance or a significant act of charity that benefits the poor. Regardless, it is important to take seriously the obligation to observe Fridays in Lent as a way of uniting ourselves to Jesus who died on Good Friday. That should not be undervalued as we reflect on His sacrifice on the Cross for the salvation of the world in this holy season."

So, while no general dispensation is being given this year, if you are at a St. Patrick's Day celebration and corned beef or some other meat is being served, it is alright to eat it. Some other type of penance should be done instead if you do eat meat on St. Patrick's Day this year. I hope that clears things up for those who were wondering. If you still need more assurance, you can call me, and I will give you a dispensation.
