


Readings for March 26, 2023

A Message From The Pastor

This has been a long and arduous process for Fr. Paul. I hope we will make him feel welcome when he returns. Our Lord asks us to treat others the way we want them to treat us. I'm sure if any of us were in Fr. Paul's position we would want others to show compassion and make us feel welcome. I hope we will do that for him. As the Cardinal states in his letter, these investigations are handled by the Archdiocese. If you have any questions or concerns about the investigation or the process that was followed, they should be addressed to the Archdiocese's Office for the Protection of Children and Youth. Again, I hope we will make Fr. Paul feel welcome when he returns. We have been preparing during these weeks of Lent to celebrate the new life Easter brings. Let's try to make this a time of new life for Fr. Paul and for our parish.

It's hard to believe it's already the 5th Sunday of Lent. Palm Sunday and Holy Week are just a week away. During Lent, we are encouraged to make use of the Sacrament of Penance, or Reconciliation as we often refer to it today. If you missed the Communal Reconciliation Service this past week, there are additional opportunities to receive this sacrament as Easter approaches. Next Saturday, April 1, we will have extended hours for confession, from 3:00 - 4:30 PM. On Tuesday, April 4, confessions will be heard from 7:00 - 8:00 PM. On Saturday, April 8, confessions will be heard from 10:00 – 11:00 AM. Please try to take advantage of these opportunities to receive this sacrament of our Lord's mercy and forgiveness.
