MISSION STATEMENT

We, the family of Most Holy Redeemer Parish, commit ourselves to enriching our relationship with God by following the teachings of Jesus Christ. With the guidance of the Holy Spirit, we continue to build the Kingdom of God in our midst. Our vision is to foster the faith of all through prayer, service, education, and ministry.

A MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR

We have started meeting with St. Bernadette and Queen of Martyrs for the *Renew My Church* initiative, which all parishes in the Archdiocese will be taking part in. We have seen parish closings and consolidations take place elsewhere as part of *Renew My Church*. While that might be the most immediate and most visible aspect of this initiative, the real goal of *Renew My Church* is threefold: to make disciples, to build community, and to inspire witness. *Renew My Church* seeks to build vibrant, sustainable faith communities that can evangelize, bringing the message of Christ to the world and bringing people to Christ and His Church.

Sometimes changes have to take place in order to build vibrant, sustainable communities of faith. There will be a meeting for our parish at a date to be determined at which any potential changes will be presented. You will have an opportunity to comment and give feedback. This will be presented to Archdiocesan leadership who will review it and present recommendations to Cardinal Cupich so he can make final decisions about any changes to parish structures.

There are three stages we work through in this renewal process. The first stage is called “Discernment and Decisions.” This is the stage we are in now. In this stage, the Grouping Feedback and Discernment Team will reflect upon potential scenarios of how our local parishes may be organized differently in the future and develop potential ideas to achieve the mission imperatives. This stage concludes when Cardinal Cupich makes his final decisions regarding any structural changes affecting the grouping (Most Holy Redeemer, Queen of Martyrs, and St. Bernadette).

The second stage is “Organizational Transition.” Once decisions are made that result in structural/organizational changes to the grouping, a dedicated support team from the Archdiocese works on-site to help pastors manage the transition – both the pastoral accompaniment to walk with people through the time of change and operational transition to ensure new parishes have strong, sustainable operational foundations, upon which the work of ministry can be built to make disciples, build community, and inspire witness.

The final stage is called “Building the New Reality.” With the structural, operational, financial, and personnel foundations in place, the grouping will vibrantly focus its efforts on vibrantly living out the three imperatives. At the core will be a culture of evangelization that supports the work of making disciples, building community, and inspiring witness. This will be a journey over the next several years.

More information about *Renew My Church* be coming. Please read the information when it appears. Please try to attend the meeting to hear what potential changes could take place and to give your feedback about those potential changes. The date for that meeting is still to be determined. It will be announced as soon as it is. Please pray for the success of the *Renew My Church* initiative.

I’m sure we are all aware of the rise in COVID cases, and the re-introduction of mitigation measures it has brought about. There are a few changes that the Archdiocese has asked us to make. We are again being required to wear masks inside church at Mass and any other services. This is regardless of vaccination status. Lectors and cantors can remove their masks when they are reading or singing, but other than that, we should keep them on. The mask requirement also applies when inside schools or other parish buildings, especially when meetings are taking place. Masks should remain on when we come forward to receive Communion. As we did prior to this past June, we should take a few steps to the side after receiving Communion, remove the mask from one ear, consume the host, put the mask on, and return to our seat.

MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR CONT.

We are also being asked to refrain from physical contact during the Sign of Peace. Based on some other directives, I suppose that those from the same household could probably make physical contact during the Sign of Peace, but we should not make physical contact beyond that.

I know this is all getting old. We want to get things back to where we were pre-pandemic. Hopefully, following these measures will help in that regard. Let's all pray for an end to this pandemic.




